- Learn about journey management considerations

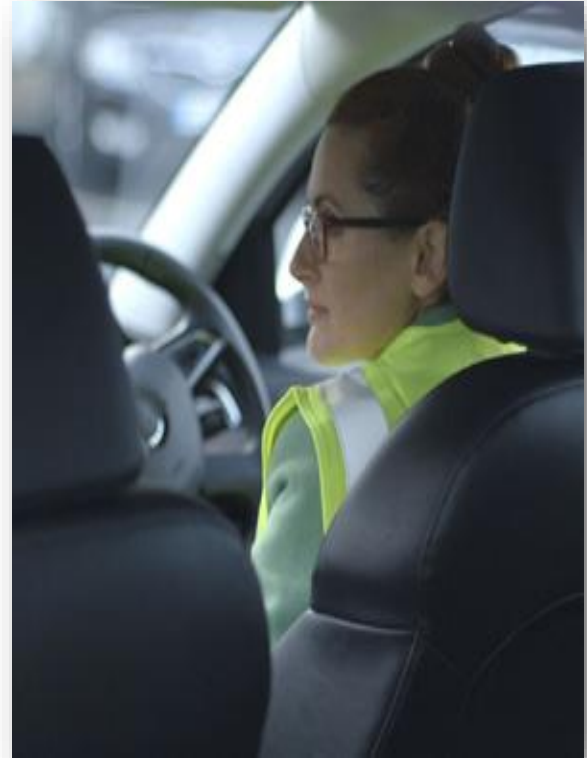
Benefits of course
